- 1. Up to three \$1,000.00 Scholarships will be awarded each year to students pursing any career in healthcare/medical field. A check will be sent to the college before the **second semester** (in January).
- Applications, using the Greene County High School, along with 3 reference letters and transcripts are due to Amy Lewman at Greene County Medical Center <u>no later than</u> <u>April 1 each year.</u>

- 3. Applicants are required to be a resident of Greene County or the Greene County Medical Center Service Area.
- 4. Three letters of recommendation with the application are due by **April 1 each year.**
- 5. Transcripts of high school and/or college grades are due by **April 1 each year.**
- 6. Applicants should call GCMC's Administrative Asistant, at GCMC, 515-386-0114, to schedule a fifteen-minute interview with the selection committee. *Interviews will be held:* Saturday, April 13, 2024, beginning at 9:00 am

 Tuesday, April 16, 2024, beginning at 3:00 pm

- 7. Recipients will be notified by mail the week following the final interviews. In addition, a certificate will be presented at the recipient's high school awards night if the recipient is a high school senior.
- 8. Recipients must mail or email their 1st semester transcript and financial aid office mailing address to Administrative Assistant, 1000 W Lincoln Way, Jefferson, Iowa 50129 or email to Amy.Lewman@gcmchealth.com in January in order for the check to be mailed.
